Safe Harbor Vice President Ray Seigfred

- Ray reported the channel is open and deep (7' – 12').
- Lake level is still high for this time of year @ ~247.12'

- There is a large rock in the middle of the channel to be aware of if / when the water drops. We'll attempt to remove it during next years channel dredging.
- A large tree fell in the boat launch. Both the Town and DEC claim it's not their responsibility to clean it up. A work detail is being planned to clean it up

Water Quality – Pres Dave Dailey

- Dave reported on the success of a water chestnut pulling event on July 11. The crew pulled all that they could find. As always, Dave expressed concern for the problems water chestnuts cause and encouraged more people to attend future pulling events.
- As a recap, Dave reported the annual weed treatment was done on June 2 with over 6,000 gallons of herbicide applied. The target weeds and areas were successfully eradicated.
- A question if the weed harvesters are coming back to focus more on the east side? Dave F thought it was on the schedule.
- A livelier discussion about the weed harvesting program in general.
Many challenges:
 - Leadership – not all towns support the program.
 - Money – some towns slow to provide funds
 - Staffing – part-time labor, etc.

Water District 10 Project

Dave Fantouzzo, Town of Huron Supervisor, Tammy Vezzose, Town of Huron Clerk, and Amy Kendall, Town of Huron Attorney attended the picnic to provide information about the project and to have people sign easements which were notarized by Tammy and /or Amy.

He provided an update on the project planned to start on the east side on August 17 bringing the water north from Lummisville Rd.

- About 130 easements are required
- Contractors are required to repair any work damages back to the original condition.
- Contractor will bring water from the east side to the west side by direct drilling under the Bay near the south end curve. Plan is to drill 20' below the hard bottom of the Bay.
- Fire hydrants to be placed per code (roughly every 600').
- **Note:** When we went to sign an easement, we discovered that few if any signatures are required of property owners on the East side. This is apparently because our "road" access is less complicated. It is suggested that you contact the Town Hall to check your status.

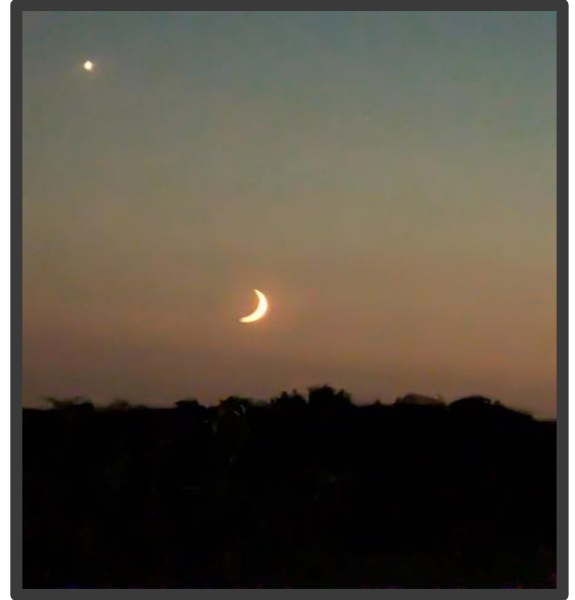
- Dave F also provided an update and preliminary map for a sewer feasibility study. More to come.

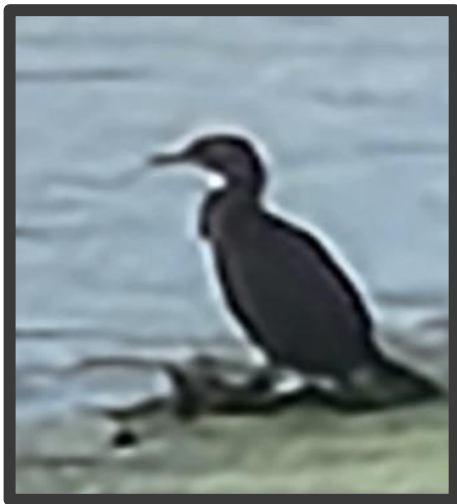
